

AGREEMENT entered into this 29th. day of September 1851,
between JOHN C. LANYON on the one part, and GEORGE P. HARRIS
on the other part, and trading together under the name of
LANYON & HARRIS, Ironmongers and Co-partners of
Hindley Street, Adelaide.

1st. That after paying all debts and liabilities,
the stock and effects of the above named Lanyon and Harris
be taken in the sum of twenty Eight Hundred Pounds, being
their joint and equal property.

2nd. That each of the said Partners draw out of
the said business One Hundred Pounds per annum.

3rd. That the remaining balance of profit, if any,
be divided as follows:- viz, that three fifths of all such
profits shall belong to the said John C. Lanyon, and the re-
maining two fifths to the said George P. Harris.
